Cheryl Sessions of ROC USA™ to Receive Award for Outstanding Service in the Public Sector/Public Interest Law

Cheryl Sessions, In-House Counsel & Director of Policy for ROC USA, LLC in Concord has been selected as the recipient of the NHBA's 2010 Outstanding Service in Public Sector/Public Interest Law award. Attorney Sessions was nominated by a fellow member of the bar, attorney Peter T. Beach of the Sheehan, Phinney, Bass & Green law firm. In the nomination letter, Cheryl's efforts to perfect a strategy to enable residents in mobile home parks to organize to purchase the mobile home parks to preserve and protect their homes was highlighted. Cheryl worked for the NH Community Loan Fund on the state level and then went on to assist Paul Bradley, formerly of the Loan Fund, to create and launch ROC USA™ to take the successful program to scale across the country.
